<p>Carmarthen Golf Club - Local Rules</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Out of Bounds: On or beyond any boundary fence or line of white posts defining the boundary of the course, the clubhouse enclosure, and the car park. Abnormal Course Conditions (Immovable Obstructions) - Rule 16: Include staked trees and all fixed sprinkler heads from which relief must be taken. Ground Under Repair (GUR) - Rule 16.1: Relief may be taken from GUR areas marked with white lines, artificially surfaced roads, and paths. Crossover Tees & Greens: When driving from holes 3 and 5 please be mindful of the safety of golfers on adjacent greens & fairways. Immediately shout "FORE" to alert golfers of any wayward shot. Penalty Areas: Yellow penalty areas marked with yellow stakes – Rule 17.1d and (2). Red penalty areas marked with red stakes - Rule 17.1d and (3). Slow Play: Slow play may be penalised under the rules of golf - Rule 5.6a. Every effort must be made to ensure the smooth running of play is maintained. Temporary Local Rules: Please refer to the club notice board at the Clubhouse for details of any temporary local rules that may be in force from time to time. Penalty for Breach of a Local Rule: Match play - loss of hole, stroke play – two strokes. 						<p>Health & Safety Advice <i>In emergencies the Club Phone No. is: 01267 281588 ext 1, 2 or 3</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Course Risk Assessment: Golfers play this course having been made aware that a full Course Risk Assessment has been conducted and is available to be read online on the Club Website. Poor Visibility: As a general guide, if on the first tee the golfer cannot see the fairway bunker then they should not play. During a round if before playing a shot, golfers cannot see the area where their ball is anticipated to land, players should not continue to play until conditions improve. Deteriorating Weather Conditions: Players should make their own informed decision as to whether to continue play. In the event of lightning, golfers should cease play and leave the course. The use of umbrellas should be avoided. Do not take shelter under trees. Awareness of Other Golfers: Players must always ensure that those in front have advanced further than they can hit their best shot. Immediately shout "FORE" to alert golfers of any wayward shot. Defibrillator: A defibrillator is located at the main entrance to the clubhouse.
